A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held March 30th, 1923 at 7:30 p. m. Present: Trustees W. <sup>D</sup>. Whitcomb and Dr. W. D. Kirkpatrick, President D. B. Waldo and the Secretary.

President Waldo recommended the retention of Mr. Sisson to continue work on the athletic field.

OPINION FROM ATTORNEY CENERAL THOMPSON:

The Secretary presented an opinion from Attorney General Thompson upon the question of whether a local improvement assessment heretofore levied against the property of the Bellingham State Normal School for street and sewer improvements may be paid from the appropriation made by **Chapter 155**, Laws of 1921, for the operation and maintenance of the Bellingham State Normal School for the biennium ending March 31, 1923. The question was answered in the negative.

BOOK STORE BOOKS TO BE AUDITED:

The President informed the Board that he had talked with Mr. Baughman, manager of the Normal Book Store, concerning the operation of the business and as there had been no check of his records for some three years, the President recommended that an immediate audit of the books of the concern be made. The recommendation was approved.

## RENEWING OF FIRE INSURANCE:

The question of renewing fire insurance on school property was gone into by the Board, who authorized the Secretary to have the expirations renewed and in addition to place new insurance as follows: On the main building,  $\frac{1}{2}66,000 - 0n$  contents in main building,  $\frac{2}{9},000 - 0n$  the dormitory, known as Ldens Hall,  $\frac{1}{3}30,000 - 0n$  the contents of Edens Hall,  $\frac{1}{2}20,000$ .
