TWENTIETH MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENTS OF THE

NOVEMBER 19, 1926.

Meeting called to order by President George Allez. Minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

An increase in the price of the 1927 Klipsun was proposed and explained by Edward Alf, business manager for the Klipsun. Discussion and further reasons for the increase were made by Sverre Arestad, ex-business manager. Ballots were submitted to students for vote. Unanimous vote decided that the December and March graduates should buy Klipsuns, and that the price of the Klipsun should be raised \$.50.

Honor System discussed. Motion made that a committee consisting of faculty members and students be appointed to investigate the principles of the Honor System and its success in other schools. Motion seconded and passed.

Motion made and seconded that a committee be appointed to investigate the feasibility of having a voting machine brought to the school for student elections. Motion lost.

Announcement was made of an auction to be held for the purpose of raising funds for the Red Cross.
