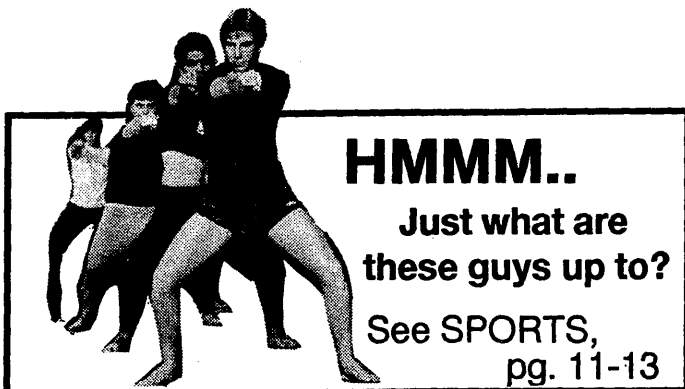

Snortimer held hostage

Hostile hippies attack, make demands

A hostile coup of Fairhaven students infiltrated President Kenneth P. Snortimer's office yesterday, barricading the doors and taking Snortimer hostage.

The group, calling themselves the Fairhaven Liberation Organization (FLO), pledged to hold President Snortimer hostage until administrators met the following demands:

- 1) Keep Fairhaven where it is.
- 2) Create a Communist Utopia at Western, in which every student is a member of the Associated Student Council.
- 3) An immediate campus-wide legalization of marijuana.
- 4) Immediate removal of Saltwater Sportsman from the AS Co-op Book Store. The magazine apparently promotes the subjugation and objectification of aquatic animals across the land.

As an after-thought, the FLO also demanded administrators make a concerted effort to end Apartheid in South Africa, return Manuel Noriega to power in Panama, peacefully resolve the Israel-Palestine conflict, save the endangered intestinal parasite of Uganda and construct a 60-foot statue of their God and figure-

head, Jerry Garcia. The FLO requested the statue be placed in Red Square, glow in the dark and produce hallucinations when its toes are licked.

The FLO declared itself a peaceful action group, following the non-violent philosophy of Gandhi, with a touch of Pec Wee Herman. However, after an administrative spokesperson refused the FLO's demands, the group announced it would begin sharpening Snortimer's fingers and toes with his electric pencil sharpener.

Administrators relented, promising to meet all the FLO's demands, with the exception of keeping Fairhaven where it is.

In an official statement to the FLO, the administration declared: "For 25 years you damn Fairhaven degenerates have been hiding back in that little commune in the trees, smoking pot and hiding from the real world while respectable people like ourselves have slaved to create a money-making university with a snobby, elitist atmosphere, just like the University of Washington.

"So now that the money is rolling in, we'd like to sit back on our laurels for awhile, kick you hippie and homo scum out on your ears, and start
