

Meeting of July 6, 1904. The Board met in adjourned regular session at the office of Trustee Minton; present Trustees & Minton, ~~Principal Mathes~~ and the Clerk. Absent, Trustee Teak.

Miss Edna Horner was elected grammar grade ~~public~~ teacher, salary \$900.00 per year.

The Clerk was instructed to secure bids for one hundred cords of alder and two hundred and seventy-five cords of fir, the bids for fir to be secured for furnishing lots of from one hundred to two hundred and seventy-five cords, and the Board by vote (unanimous) empowered the Clerk to let the contract for furnishing wood to the lowest bidder.
