BOARD OF CONTROL MEETINGS

Summer quarter - 1937

July 14, 1937

The meeting was called to order and the minutes were read.

Sybil Hinchcliffe, editor of the Western Viking presented the following statement of the Viking's financial condition for the summer:

83.60 deficit from last quarter
264.00 printing and casting
13.50 pins
60.00 Editor's salary
3.00 initiation
<u>18.20 office supplies</u>
490.30 grand total needed for summer
150.66 expected from ads

340.30 money needed from A.S.U.
<u>192.00 allotted by A.S.U.</u>
148.00 needed but not budgeted

Two recommendations from Mrs. Ruth Burnet, journalism advisor, for the employment of an advertising manager at \$1 per week salary and for granting of a 20% bonus on all ads over 70 column inches a week were rejected. The motion was made and carried to appropriate \$142 from the social fund for the Viking debt, \$6 being subtracted from the original request since there will be no advertising manager.

The applications of Sandison's and Vinson's photograph studios were considered for the Klipsun work for 1937-1938. The motion was made and carried to let the contract to Vinson's.

It was decided to hold a Rec hour the first week of the second term. After discussion, it was agreed upon that the hours of Rec hour should remain as usual, from 8:00 to 11:00, instead of later.
