PROGRAM COURSES

5 CREDITS

FREN 301 – French Language in Montréal

- Morning classes 4x/week

5 CREDITS

FREN 385 – Culture and Conversation (French Culture in Montréal)

- Afternoon/Evening activities 3-4x/week

PRE-REQ: FR 203 or equivalent

PROGRAM BENEFITS

FR 301 is a REQUIRED course for all students majoring/minoring in French.

FR 385 is a REQUIRED course for all students majoring in French and an ELECTIVE course for all students minoring in French.

Upon completing this summer program, all students minoring in French will have to take one more course to complete their program requirements.

PROGRAM COST

Approximate cost per student:
\$6,585

Included in program cost: Lodgings in UQAM residence, insurance, weekend excursions, some meals

Not included in program cost: Airfare, textbook, most meals, incidentals (yet we have a very favorable currency exchange rate!)

MONTREAL

Montreal is the second largest city in Canada. It is:

- extremely culturally and ethnically diverse.
- known for reasonably-priced, world renown eateries (think bagels, smoked meat, poutine...).
- served by a great transit system and is pedestrian-friendly
- an ideal location to learn about America's northern neighbors.

- Montréal hosts a long list of popular festivals every summer, including the world's largest comedy festival, JUSTE POUR RIRE, LES NUITS D'AFRIQUE, an African music festival, and L'INTERNATIONAL DES FEUX, an international fireworks competition. Very popular with students!
